Description;

This candidate will have a strong work ethic, a desire to grow spiritually and a willingness to serve through hard work.

Since we are a small camp you should expect not only to fulfill your primary job description, but also to participate in many other areas as needed.

That being said, the following is a basic description of responsibilities of our "Crew" positions.

- Daily cleaning of camp cabins, meeting rooms and bathroom facility.
- Willingness to be trained in use of camp vehicles, equipment, boats and tools.
- Willingness to be trained as a lifeguard.
- Work on and maintain our waterfront and recreation areas. This would include helping with our kayaks, snorkel shop and boat cleaning to name a few.
- Opportunities to spend some time learning to work in our wood shop and maintenance shop as your interest and skills apply.
- Ongoing work with our fire clearance needs. (Weed eaters, chain saws, hand saws, etc.)
- Ability to work independently, as well as part of a team and have a willingness to help lead volunteer groups.

Living at Campus by the Sea is a unique experience. We are an island camp 20 miles off the coast of Los Angeles and are 3 miles away from the town of Avalon, and are only accessible by boat.

Most of our staff live in shared housing with occasional opportunities for couple or family housing.

As part of our commitment to living together here at CBS we participate in regular activities together that are outside of our normal "work responsibilities". An example of some of these would be daily devotions, weekly bible studies and a time set aside to share what is going on in each others lives and pray for each other.

Our summer also includes a weekly church service.

Pay is approx \$200 per week plus room and board. There are also some paid holiday days depending on your term of service.
